- Non-recyclable Packaging
- Polystyrene
- Food Waste (Less than 5kg produced per week)
- Ceramics
- Other non-recyclable and residual waste

(Applies to business who produce more than 5kg of food waste a week. For Food Waste Only).

- Paper
- Cardboard Packaging
- Corrugated Cardboard

- Clean Recyclable Plastic Packaging
- Empty Drinks Cartons
- Empty Cans & Tins
- Clean Foil

- Glass Bottles
- Glass Jars

## Preparation for Collection

General Waste items to be placed in black bags for collection.

Food waste can be placed either loosely in bin or in "Clear Bin Liner".

Please place recycling in clear bags - black bags will not be collected. All items need to be free of liquid and residue.

Glass Waste needs to be placed loosely in the bin - no bags required.


